



Next, I clicked on the minus button for the other areas.



I was then able to click on these items and drop them into the prescription. Notice that they have been surrounded by blue again. I suggest if you want to delete text in any of the boxes in the RxEdit screen, use the minus button – don't use the backspace or delete key on your keyboard.



In this screen, I demonstrate that the strength and formulation of the nifedipine can be changed easily by clicking on the desired choice in the left panel.

One advantage of the new RxEdit screen is that I can start at “1 tablet” and tab from one box to the next, free texting in any changes without having to stop and drop into the keypad screen. For me, this represents a significant change for the better – in spite of the glitches.
