



## Revised Adult Vaccine Availability Table

### Eligibility:

- MDPH **no** longer provides vaccines for adults seen at private provider sites.
- MDPH provides a **very** limited supply of some vaccines for adults seen in public sector sites<sup>1</sup>.
- State supplied vaccine at these public sites should be **prioritized** for the highest risk adults<sup>2</sup> without insurance or for adults who are under-insured.
- **Exception:** Td vaccine will be available at both public and private sector sites (and influenza vaccine for the 2008-2009 season that has already been allocated).

The **only** vaccines currently provided by MDPH for adults are outlined in the table below.

<sup>1</sup> **Public Sector Sites:** Places where adults get immunized, including: local health departments; community health centers; STD clinics; integrated counseling, testing and referral sites; correctional facilities; public hospitals; and other public providers who have received state-supplied vaccines.
